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6 Day Humanitarian Experience

MACHU PICCHU

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DAY 1

JULY 16: ARRIVE IN CUZCO PERU. Our representatives will transport you to our lovely accommodations in Cuzco, at the new JW Marriott Hotel. This new five star hotel was a former monastery and is wonderfully located just a couple of blocks from the central square. After a long journey from the U.S., today will be a free day to relax and acclimate to the high altitude of Cuzco. You may explore the city at your own pace and visit the local shops, restaurants or enjoy the hotel's meditation pool, steam bath, sauna and Jacuzzi. DAY 2

JULY 17: We will enjoy breakfast at the hotel followed by volunteer work. Here is a sample of what we have planned:



AZUL WASI IS A HOME FOR STREET CHILDREN:

This project is located about 45 minutes outside the center of Cuzco in Oropesa, the bread capital of Peru. It is a home for children who were living on the streets. These children have been abandoned and found on the streets or come from very poor backgrounds. Currently, there are 20 children living there from ages 7 to 20 years old. This is a growing project with 3 dormitories for the children, a room for learning and activities, a kitchen and dining room.

Chickens, geese and turkeys are raised at the home and part of their dietary consumption. The children have built a guinea pig structure to farm guinea pigs, a delicacy in Peru. They farm guinea pigs and sell them to restaurants locally. The children also maintain a vegetable garden on site. Volunteers today might assist in gardening, painting, teaching English, helping with homework, art activities or organized sports games.

Present needs for Azul Wasi include: Financial assistance to support the construction of a new green house, materials for educational activities, 3 second hand computers for the children and used clean clothes in good condition. This project promotes food, health, education and a safe home from the streets.



DAY 3

JULY 18: SACRED VALLEY PRIVATE TOUR in a Mercedes Benz Sprinter bus. We will be enjoying the beauty of the scenery, following the Vilcanota River towards the west and the Pisac Valley. It is also a beautiful region to view splendid snowcapped peaks in the surrounding area. We will tour the archeological sites and ruins of Morey and Ollantaytambo. Moray is one of the most visually stunning Inca ruins. In a large bowl-like depression, is constructed a series of concentric terraces that looks like a Greek amphitheater. The archeological site of Ollantaytambo was one of the last areas in which construction was performed by the Incas before the arrival of the Spaniards. Afterwards, we will host your lunch at Tunupa restaurant in Urubamba before we return to Cuzco.

Day 4

JULY 19: MACHU PICCHU is considered a masterpiece of architecture and engineering by the Incas. Its geographical location and physical setting make Machu Picchu a dream-like place with exceptional beauty comparable to the most beautiful scenery created by nature and embellished by the hand of man.

Early in the morning, our drivers will transport us to the train station for our train departure at approx. 6:40am in a "Vista Dome" train to Machu Picchu (the glass roof in the train allows you to enjoy the spectacular mountain scenery.) Arriving at approx. 10am, we will take a bus up to the ruins, and we will have a 3 hour private English guided tour. Lunch will be provided at Indio Feliz restaurant in Aguas Calientes. Train departs at 3:20pm to Cuzco with an arrival time of approx. 7pm.

DAY 5

JULY 20: FREE DAY, it is your turn to pick your adventure! Here are some suggestions: This is a great time to do some local shopping. We have in the past purchased beautiful handmade items: tapestry, art work, alpaca hats, scarves, and interesting souvenirs, all within walking distance of our hotel. All levels of quality may be found here. Maybe you will find a Cuzco treasure too! If you are hooked now on Inca ruins and culture, you might take a taxi to Sacsayhuaman, less than a half hour away. These ruins are also fantastic! (Entrance fee required) Close to the hotel is a lovely cathedral and other interesting old buildings. Ancient Inca stonework exhibits itself here and there as you walk along charming cobblestone streets near our J.W. Marriott Hotel. Enjoy the luxuries of our hotels tranquility pool, sauna, steam bath, or spa services.

DAY 6

JULY 21: Have a leisurely breakfast, take a final stroll down the cobble stone streets of Cuzco and our transportation services will take you to the airport for your flight back to the U.S.
